

How to turn on Closed-Captioning on DirecTV

1. Make sure the slide on the top of your remote is slid FAR to the left – to the DirecTV setting.



2. Point the remote control toward the cable box. While watching a live TV program (not a commercial) – press the YELLOW button on the remote.

3. Use the arrow buttons to move over to the “CC”

4. When you highlight “CC” – you will see three choices, OFF, DirecTV Subtitles, and Closed Captioning

What is the difference between “DirecTV Subtitles” and “Closed Captioning”???

DirecTV Subtitles – shows up against the TV picture like this:



Closed Captioning looks like this: Closed Captioning looks like this

5. Use the arrow buttons to highlight your choice – either “**DirectTV Subtitles**” or “**Closed Captioning**” – Press the **ORANGE “select”** button

6. Wait a few seconds – and the subtitles will appear over the video on your screen

Closed Captioning does not work on all receivers – especially with older TVs – if it won't work, call 877-598-6636.
